Based on a 2016 survey

- Fear of socialized medicine
- Fear of high taxes
- Fear of the unknown future
- Fear of the effect on state finances
- Fear of the board of ColoradoCare being unaccountable
- Fear that the system cannot work in Colorado alone
- Fear that billing will be too complex
- Fear that malpractice is not addressed
- Fear that Medicare patients get no benefits
- Fear that the practice environment will be worse for physicians

Health Care in the New Era

- ACA –
 - repeal and replace; ? time frame
 - cuts in Medicaid, subsidies, ? CHIP
